West Virginia Manufacturing Facts

- Manufacturers in West Virginia account for 10.07% of the total output in the state, employing 8.6% of the workforce.
- Total output from manufacturing was \$7.94 billion in 2019.
- There were an average of 47,000 manufacturing employees in West Virginia in 2020, with an average annual compensation of \$74,726.77 in 2019. (National Association of Manufacturers, 2023)

Manufacturing Exports

Manufacturers help drive West Virginia's economy! Manufactured goods accounted for \$3.01 billion in exports in 2020 with half (\$1.52 billion) being through our free trade agreement (FTA) partners.

US Manufacturing Exports

The 20 U.S. FTA partners purchased 48.3% (\$659.49 billion) of U.S. manufactured goods exports in 2019 – even though these countries represent only six percent of the world's population and 10 percent of GDP.

FTA countries: Australia, Bahrain, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Jordan, Mexico, Morocco, Nicaragua, Oman, Panama, Peru, Singapore and South Korea.








Manufacturing Employment by WV County




